Invitation and Venue

It is our great pleasure to invite you to the 10th International Congress of the Serbian Society of Mechanics. The Congress will be held in Niš, Serbia, from June 18–20, 2025. Niš is one of the oldest cities in Europe and has been a significant center throughout history. It is known as the birthplace of the Roman Emperor Constantine the Great and offers numerous historical landmarks, such as the Niš Fortress, the Archaeological Hall, and the Skull Tower. Today, Niš is also a vibrant academic and technological hub, home to multiple universities and innovation centers.

Objectives

The 10th International Congress of the Serbian Society of Mechanics aims to bring together leading academic scientists, researchers, and scholars to exchange and share their experiences and research results in various aspects of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics.
